The CLOC-SAT Final Report is a community document that will be used to plan future lunar orbital missions

The Continuous Lunar Orbital Capabilities Specific Action Team (CLOC-SAT) developed integrated findings that addressed questions associated with lunar orbital capabilities in the years ahead, in particular: Why? How? and What?

- These interwoven issues essentially refer to the rationale, specific needs/goals, and realistic opportunities/capabilities for assets in orbit to carry lunar science and exploration forward during the next decade(s)
- The Final Report describes 9 Overarching Findings, 69 Topical Findings, 2 Traceability Tables, and references 14 Supporting Community White Papers
- APL staff were key contributors to leading the effort, collecting community inputs, deliberating prioritizations drafting the report, and producing white papers
